**General Guidelines and instructions for election of Class Representative**

**I. Disassociation of Student Elections and Student Representation from Political Parties.**

During the period of the elections no person, who is not a student on the rolls of the college/university, shall be permitted to take part in the election process in any capacity.

Any person, candidate, or member of the student organization, or a member of a registered Political party, violating this rule shall be subject to disciplinary proceedings, in addition to the candidature, as the case may be, being revoked.

**II. Eligibility Criteria for Candidates**

1. All **registered student** of Pre Law –I/II/III/IV/V and LL.B- I/II/III for Academic Year 2022-2023.
2. The candidate should have attained the minimum percentage of attendance as prescribed by the university or 75% attendance, whichever is higher in its previous year or in the same year of the election for the students of first year in the campus.
3. The candidate shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of office bearer,
4. The candidate shall not have a previous criminal record, that is to say he should not have been tried and/or convicted of any criminal offence or misdemeanor. The candidate shall also not have been subject to any disciplinary action by the College Authorities .
5. The candidate must be a regular, full time student of the College.
6. All eligible candidates must be enrolled in a full time course, the course duration being at least one year.

**III. Code of Conduct for Candidates and Elections Administrators:**

1. No candidate shall indulge in, nor shall abet, any activity, which may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes and communities, religions or linguistic, or between any group(s) of students.
2. Criticism of other candidates, when made, shall be confined to their policies and programs, past record and work. Candidates shall refrain from criticism of all aspects of private life, not connected with the public activities of the other candidates or supporters of such other candidates. Criticism of other candidates or their supporters based on unverified allegations or distortion shall be avoided.
3. There shall be no appeal to caste or communal feelings for securing votes. Places of worship, within or outside the campus shall not be used for election propaganda. No political face can be used for canvassing purpose or other purpose during the election.





4. All candidates shall be prohibited from indulging or abetting in activities which are considered to be "corrupt practices" and offences, such as bribing of voters, intimidation of voters, impersonation of voters, canvassing or the use of propaganda beyond prescribed limit, and holding public meetings.
5. No candidate will utilize name of any district, state or national level students' organizations/Union/Parishad on the poster or on banner or on anything which could identify him or her as a candidate of that organization.
6. No candidate shall be permitted to carry out processions, or public meetings, or in any way canvass or distribute propaganda outside the university campus/college campus.
7. No candidate shall, nor shall his/her supporters, deface or cause any destruction of any property on the university/college campus, for any purpose whatsoever, without the prior written permission of the college/university authorities. All candidates shall be held jointly and severally liable for any destruction/defacing of any university/college property.
8. The use of loudspeakers, vehicles and animals for the purpose of canvassing shall be prohibited.
9. On the day of polling, student organizations and candidates shall:
  - a. co-operate with the officers on election duty to ensure peaceful and orderly polling and complete freedom to the voters to exercise their franchise without being subjected to any annoyance or obstruction;
  - b. not serve or distribute any eatables, or other solid and liquid consumables, except water on polling day;
  - c. not hand out any propaganda on the polling day.
10. Excepting the voters, no one without a valid I-card/letters of the authority from the College authorities shall enter the polling booths.
11. All candidates shall be jointly responsible for ensuring the cleaning up of the polling area within 48 hours of the conclusion of polling.
12. Any contravention of any of the above recommendations may make the candidate liable to be stripped of his candidature or his elected post, as the case may be. The college authorities may also take appropriate disciplinary action against such a violator.
13. In addition to the above-mentioned code of conduct, it is also recommended that certain provisions of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 153-A and Chapter IX-A "Offences Relating to Elections"), may also be made applicable to student elections.

#### **IV. Maintaining Law and Order on the Campus during the Election Process:**

Any instance of acute lawlessness or the commission of a criminal offence shall be reported to the police by the college authorities as soon as possible.

**The Student Bar Association:** The Student Bar Association shall consist of Eight office bearers and Sixteen members elected by the Class Representatives from among themselves.

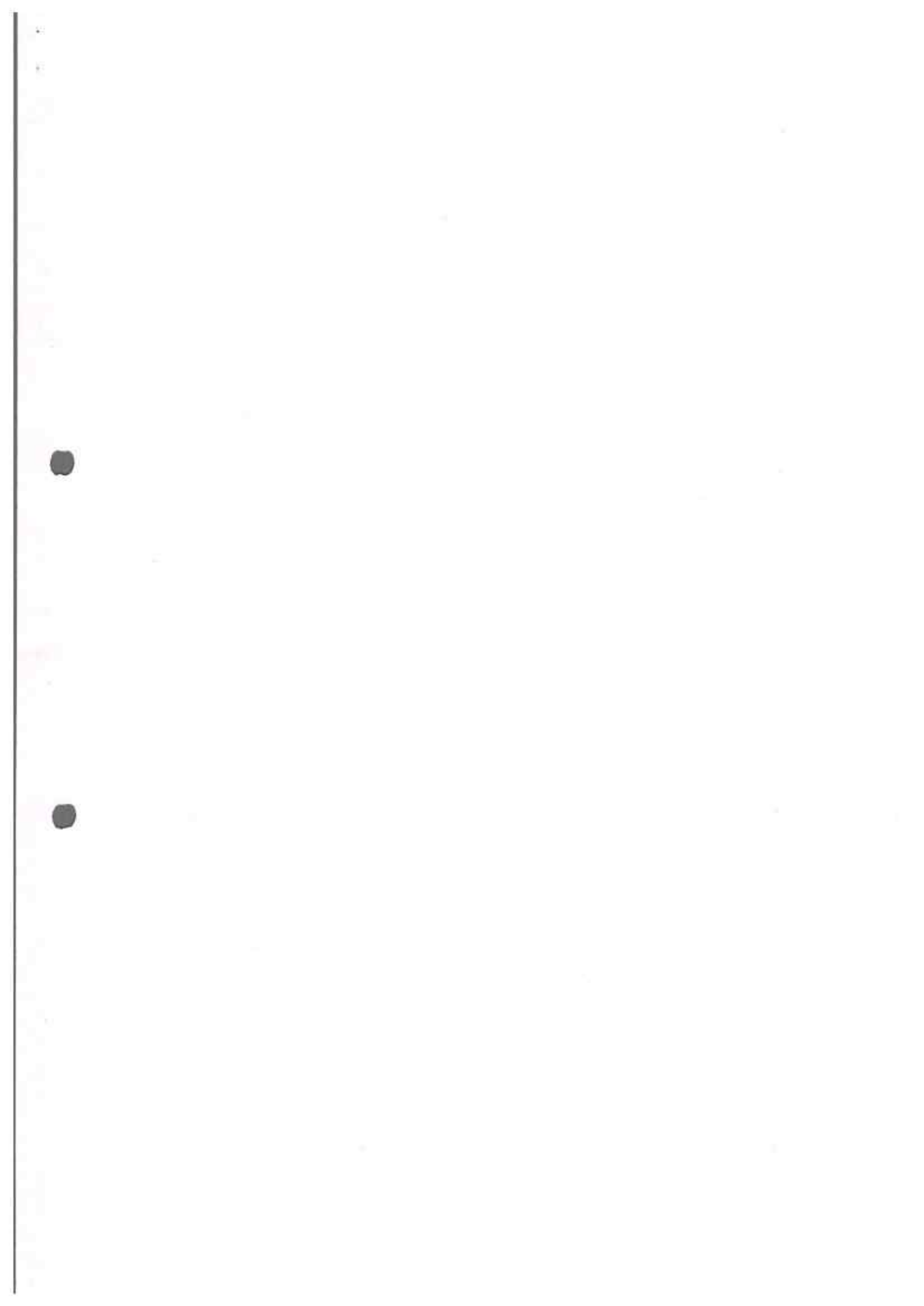


