

RULES & REGULATIONS

E.3.31.

 Unless the context other wise requires, the definition of the words used in the Rules & regulations shall be as under:

1) Society :-

 Society means "Bharativishw Alumni Association, Sangli, Tal. Miraj, Dist, Sangli"

II. Member :-

Member means any person who has applied to the society, after complying with the conditions of the society and who has been admitted as member after sanction of executive committee of the society.

III. Executive Council :-

Executive committee means committee of 7 persons who have been selected or elected by the General Meeting of the society for the period specified.

Iv. Meetings :-

Meetings Means meeting which is called for considering the issues after consultation with the members of society.

2) Jurisdiction :-

All Over Maharashtra State,

3) Accounting Year :-

Accounting year shall balancing on 31st March every year.

4) Membership and Registration of Members :-

The persons Indian citizens who are ready to behave as per the rules and regulation and who have faith in the objects and aim of the Society and who have completed age of 18 year may became member of the society. The entrance fee shall be Rs. 10/-(Ten Only) and Annual Subscription shall be Rs 100/- (Rs One Hundred Only). The person /-who intends to become member of the society shall apply in specified form to be filled completely with recommendation of two members of Executive committee along with their signatures and which is Sanctioned by 2/3 Majority shall become the member of Society and he will enjoy all right of membership. Membership of those members who does not pay annual subscription fees will be terminated.

5) CATEGORY OF MEMBERS :-

a) Founder Members :-

The members who are members at the time of establishment of the society and pay Rs. 100/- (Rs. One Hundred Only) on the event of establishment will be founder members of the society.

b) General Members :-

The members who pay annual Subscription of Rs. 100/- (Rs One Hundred Only) regularly will be General Members. The said annual subscription may be changed; by executive committee at general meeting. The said subscription shall not be refunded at any cost.

c) Life Members :-


The persons who gives Rs.1000/- (Rs. One Thousand Only) to the society Will be called as life Member of the society

Well-wishing Member :d)

The persons who give help to the society such as financial, in kind or other facilities etc. will be called as well-wishing member of society. They will not have any right to vote.

Cancellation of Membership :-6)

- Membership of society will be automatically cancelled on happening of i) Death, II) Resignation III) Mental retardation Iv) Punishment for serious (5 offence v) Miss behavior against the objects of society vi) the person who doesn't gives annual Subscription or any other event which disqualifies any person from entering into contract under any act for the time being in force,
- If the society wants to expel any member from society said member he will be charge sheeted and he will be heard on the point and he will be expelled b) by executive committee after consent of the executive committee.

Rights and Restrictions of Member :-0)


- To ask any questions or to put proposals for fulfillment of objects and aims of the society in writing or oral ai the time of Annual 1) General Meeting,
- To express his or her opinion at the time of annual General Meeting, H)
- To exercise franchise during election of executive committee to accept or resist any proposal, to suggest any new programs, of Executive committee, to co-operate Executive committee and to try for the improvement of society, election
- To see the record of society with prior permission of secretary or President except the record confidential records. iv)
- That a member shall be precluded to disclose any secrete matter relating the aims achievement & of daily routine work of the society. V)
- If any kind of disputes is created in relation with the officials of the society it shall be firstly consulted with President, then to Executive VI) Committee and lastly it shall be put in Annual General Meeting or it may be handed over for solution to an eldest member as arbitrator and decision of said arbitrator shall be binding. The member shall not raise the matter to police or newspapers.

Annual General Meeting, It's Rights and Functions :-7)

- Annual General Meeting shall be called within 6 Months from the expiration of date of Accounting year. All accounts and necessary report shall be ready A) for the said Annual General Meeting. It shall keep in the annual general meeting for sanction.
- The persons who may be helpful to society may be invited to the Annual General Meeting with resolution in the meeting of Executive Committee. But B) the said person shall not have voting right.
- The President of Annual General Meeting, shall confirm the quorum of the Meeting personally. Prior to conduct the meeting the notice of said Annual C) General Meeting Notice shall be issue before 15 days of meeting date. The meeting notice posted or by hand to members. The signatures with name of members shall be obtained who are present to such meeting. There shall be noting of every meeting in the minutes book. So also proceeding book shall be mentioned regarding the resolution, which were placed for and passed by In the said meetings.

Functions at Annual General Meeting (AGM) :-D)

To read and to sanction to previous meeting proceeding. sarangal Secretary Vice President



- To elect new Executive Body with majority for every five years.
- To accept the report of annual accounts presented by the Executive Committee.
- To appoint Chartered Accountant for Auditing of the society.
- 5) To give approval if changes or correction in rules & regulations
- To discuss on aims & objects of the society.
- To discuss and decide on any other matters as may be brought forward to the meeting, with the permission of President. Specific agenda may be prepared by the executive committee before each AGM.

8) Notice of Annual General Meeting and Quorum :-

- A) The notice of Annual General Meeting shall be issued before 15 days of Annual General Meeting. If any member has not been served the notice of Annual General Meeting even after that through Register A.D. post or by Hand delivery, there shall not be any bar to the resolutions which are passed in Annual General Meeting
- B) Quorum of said meeting shall be 2/3 out of total members. The meeting, which is postponed due to quorum, shall be called after 1/2 hour at the same place. There shall be no requirement of Quorum to such meeting. This shall be mentioned in the said notice.

9) Special General Meeting :-

- A) If Executive Committee decides to put up any important matter for discussion of members, a Special General Meeting shall be called. The rules of Annual General Meeting shall be followed except the rule of Quorum.
- B) If 3/5 members out of total give notice of Sp. General Meeting and sends it to Executive Committee for consideration, it would be necessary for the President to call special general meeting after taking decision at the Executive committee meeting.

10) Executive Committee and Officials of Society :-

- A) 1) There shall be Executive Committee containing total 7 members. There shall be 1 to 4 President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and other Three (5 to 7) members shall Constitute Executive Committee.
- The Executive Committee Members shall remain minimum 7 and maximum 15 but the changes should be taken approval of Annual General Meeting.
- If Executive Committee finds necessity of Consulting Committee, Executive Committee may from consulting committee.
- It the Executive Committee finds necessity of sub committee, it may form one or more sub committees. May form consulting committee.
- 5) If any member or official of Executive Committee remains absent for three consistent meetings without assigning any written reason he shall be treated terminated automatically. There shall be no need to issue notice to said member.

11) Period of Executive Committee :-

The period of Executive Committee shall be 5 years. After five years the Executive Committee shall elected in Annual General Meeting with Majority. Such elected executive body shall be send to Public Trust office in the prescribed manner within time limit. If necessary the election will be held Secrete voting method.

12) Official of Executive Committee and their Functions :-

There shall be President, Vice-president, Secretary and their Functions shall be as under.

PRESIDENT :-

- To look after and control in all work of Society.
- To sign all documents dt society and to look after daily transactions of society.
- To preside over Executive Committee meetings and Annual 'General meetings and Special General Meeting.
- To give casting vote at the lime of equal voting.
- If secretary falls to perform his duties then call meeting of Executive Committee or Annual Meeting and to take decision as regards the failure of working of secretary.

VICE-PRESIDENT :-

To perform all duties in the absences of President and to help President in daily transaction & program of society.

SECRETARY:

- To Act as per directions of President and as per the aims objects and motive of society and to look after day to day transaction of society.
- To call meetings as Executive Committee and AGM as per the directions of President and to keep minuets and proceeding books.
- To act as mediator between Executive Committee and the society and to watch on the daily working of servants.
- To look after correspondence of society and to keep record of society.
- 5) To deposits amount which is collected in the name of society in nominated Bank and to do ancillary duties. The secretary can keep cash in Hand for daily expenditure up to Rs. 1,000/-.
- To keep note books, receipt Books, Voucher etc. as required by Society.
- To keep accounts of society.

TREASURER:-


- Treasurer should strictly follow the orders of President.
- To prepare Annual P&L, Balane Sheet, Annual Estimate and other important returns and send it in prescribed format to concerned department.
- To sanction expenditure vouchers, to sign on receipts, and to maintain movable & immovable property.
- To keep accounting books and concerned registers in good condition.
- Amounts collected/received in the name of Society shall be deposited on the same date till evening or on next day in morning in the account of Society.
- Treasurer shall keep index of members and to keep proper accounts of their subscriptions.
- To accept time to time receiving amounts, donations, subscriptions, entry fees, funds, items/things and issue printed receipts with address of society thereon in serially numbered.
- To comply with the fault, drawback, blame shown by Auditors.

- All members of executive council have to strictly follow the orders of President and to help secretary on his permission whenever necessary. 1)
- To attend every meeting. 21
- To keep watch on society's working. 3)
- To cast vote in election. 4)

- To do all those work to know the name of society in the public.

Meetings of Executive Committee and Demand to schedule Meeting:-13)

At least One meeting shall be called within 3 months, in case of special occasion, for important and urgent decision where there is no sufficient time to call meeting with permission of President written opinion will be called for and on the majority of said written opinion the said resolution may he passed or rejected and the said resolution may be sectioned.

Notice of Meeting of Executive Committee and quorum :-14.

- Notice of meeting of Executive Committee shall be issued at least 7 (Seven) 1) days before meeting.
- Quorum of Executive Committee meeting shall be 4 when 7 members executive committee is present. If the meeting is not conducted due to 2) Insufficient Quorum; it shall be held after half an hour at the same place. This note must be inserted in the notice of meeting.

Rules of Election of Executive Council: 15)

Election of Executive Council will be held every 5 years as per above mentioned rule 4, 6, 10 & 11 in Annual General Meeting. After election of Executive Council in the first 7 days meeting of executive council will be held with prior permission of President. Executive Council will start their working after sanction of Executive Council. Election shall be held either by Secrete Voting or by majority voting Method.

16) To Fulfill the Vacancy in Executive Committee :-

If executive committee members any post become vacant due to death resignation or any other reason. At that time the executive committee shall fulfill such vacant post from members of the society. The new members duration shall lie for remaining period of Executive Body.

17) Rights and Functions of Executive Committee :-

Common Meeting :-


After the selection of members of Executive Committee in Annual General Meeting, the common meeting of new arid out going members of Executive Committee shall be called within 8 days by out going President without any delay. In the said Meeting-outgoing President shall hand-over the charge in writing along with record of society, documents, movable and immovable property and other properties to New President and it shall be along with signatures.

- After New Executive Committee is formed, the Change Report shall be submitted to Asst. Charity Commissioner Office, Sangli along with names of members of Executive Committee & office bearers by the President without any delay.
- Right to operate Account of society in the banks shall he given by out going office bearers to new office bearers. The said documents shall be prepared at

the time of meeting mentioned above in section A.

- To look after the daily business, to appoint servants to transfer retirement, to handle, cash transactions, to watch on servants and to look after ancillary
- To prepare further society budget accounts etc. and place in the Annual General Meeting and obtain sanction in Annual General Meeting.
- To prepare the and maintain the accounts of the society as per procedure mentioned in The Bombay Public Trust Act 1950 and it shall be audited by Chartered Accountant and it shall be send to on office of charity commissioner in specified form within given time.
- The information and particulars of the persons who are appointed by society shall be sent to office of Charity Commissioner accordingly in the form and manner specified in section 4- A of Societies Registration Act 1860 and rule 8, Schedule 2 of Rule 1971 form of Schedule 2 which is annexed along with this rules and regulations.
- To get the accounts of society audited by local auditor and to prepare, Profit and Loss account, report etc. and place before annual General Meeting.
- To do ancillary work as per rules.

Funds, Property of Society and its appropriation :-18)

The society can raise funds by collecting donations by raising loans with or without interest, by performing cultural program or by any other lawful the subscription of members may be used for increasing the funds of society.

19) Arrangement for Expenditure :-

The Funds of society shall expend on the object of the society equally. But the executive committee have power to amend the provision as per the circumstances & situations.

Loan or Deposits :-20)

If society wants avail to loan facility it can avail loan from Banks or Financial Institutions. It can also raise the same from private sources. The said loan shall be appropriated for the objects and aim of society. The provisions of The Bombay Public Trust Act 1950 shall be followed regarding loan raising.

Procedure Regarding Sale and Purchases of Immovable property :-21)

The society shall follow the provisions mentioned in the The Bombay Public Trust Act 1950, Rule 36 but prior permission of Hon. Joint Charity Commissioner, Kolhapur is necessary,

22) Bank Account and Cash Transactions :-

An account may be opened in the name of society in any Nationalized or Cooperative Bank -which will be decided by Executive Body. The Bank account may be operated by any two signatures among President & vice President or Secretary, but the signature of President is essential. Executive committee can vest this power as per convenience, to anyone of the above named officers of the society.

Procedure regarding Member list :-23)



26) Dissolution :-

Procedure under Section 13 and 14 of The Societies Registration Act 1860 shall be followed if society is to be dissolved.




















Bharati Vidyapeeth's New Law College, Sangli Guest Lecture on Avenues in Legal Profession

More than 60 students attend the orientation programme. This orientation programme helpful to student and clear the basic idea of skit.




SKIT COMPETITION

Date: 16 January 2020







Inter-Class Moot Court Competition 2022


Date- 26th May, 2022

Inter-Class Group Song Competition Report


