Code of Conduct

Internship program

On Thursday ,23rd September 2021, the college organized an Induction Program for the students of Pre Law I and LLB I to provide information regarding various visits, Internship as well to discuss in detail how to maintain the internship diaries ,code of conduct i.e. discipline etc. At the outset, Prof. Smita Adimani welcomed the participants and elaborated the importance of Internship program that is made compulsory for law students as per BCI Part IV, Schedule III, and Rule 25. Then, Prof. Sanjeevkumar Sable explained the students how the internship program helps them to put the theoretical foundations of law into practice and acquaints the students about the procedural aspects of law, and give them real life experience about law and make them familiar with the Court environment. In addition to this he provided the detailed information regarding different Law enforcing institutions and different paralegal activities. He told the students about how and where they can complete the internship. Moreover, he also guided the students how to do projects by selecting legal subjects and how to maintain the internship diaries.



Prof .SanjayAher guided the students regarding minute things to be taken into consideration while writing Internship diary. He explained the students the purpose of visits to law implementing agencies like Police station, Children's home, Forensic lab, Courts etc. As well he guided the students regarding internal and external viva as well the evaluation process of university regarding internship. Principal, Dr. Pooja Narwadkar explained the protocol to be followed in court while attending the court and during visits to different institutions. She gave minute instructions to boys and girls regarding dress code, use of cell phones and mannerism. She enlightened the students regarding Lok adalat and marked the points to be observed during attending the legal proceedings in Lok adalat . She encouraged the students to attend different online seminars and workshops and answered the queries of the students. She appealed the students to take maximum benefit of this Internship program for enriching their real life experiences as well develop their knowledge depository.

Induction Program for Newcomers


Tuesday, 30th March 2021

Legal Aid and Internship







Induction Program
