



The college has mechanisms addressing gender concerns on the campus. The policy of this committee is to create zero tolerance to harassment.

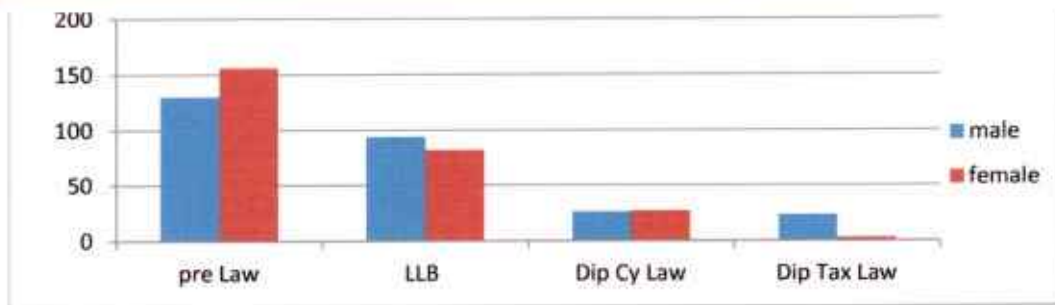

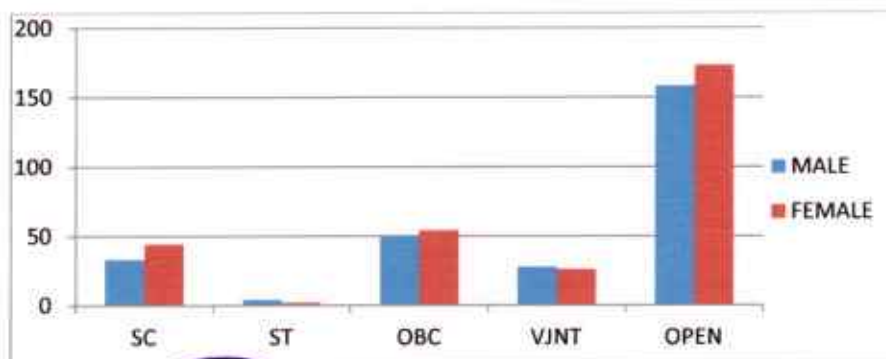

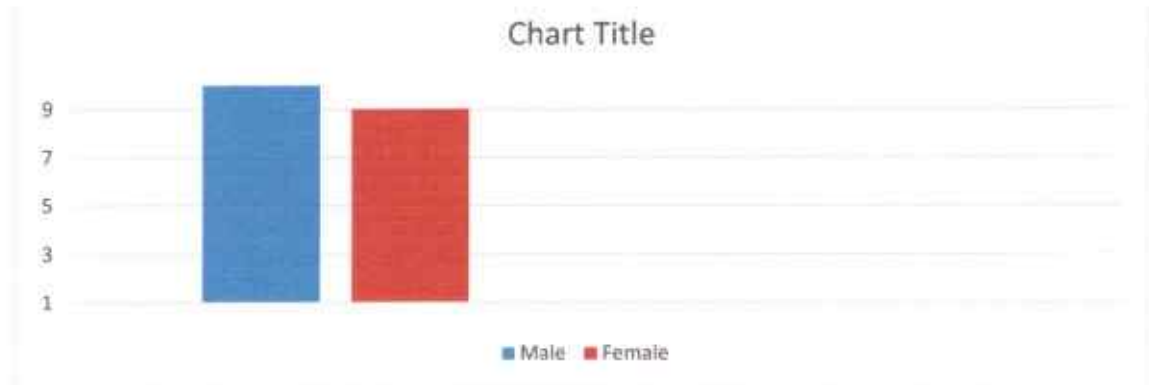

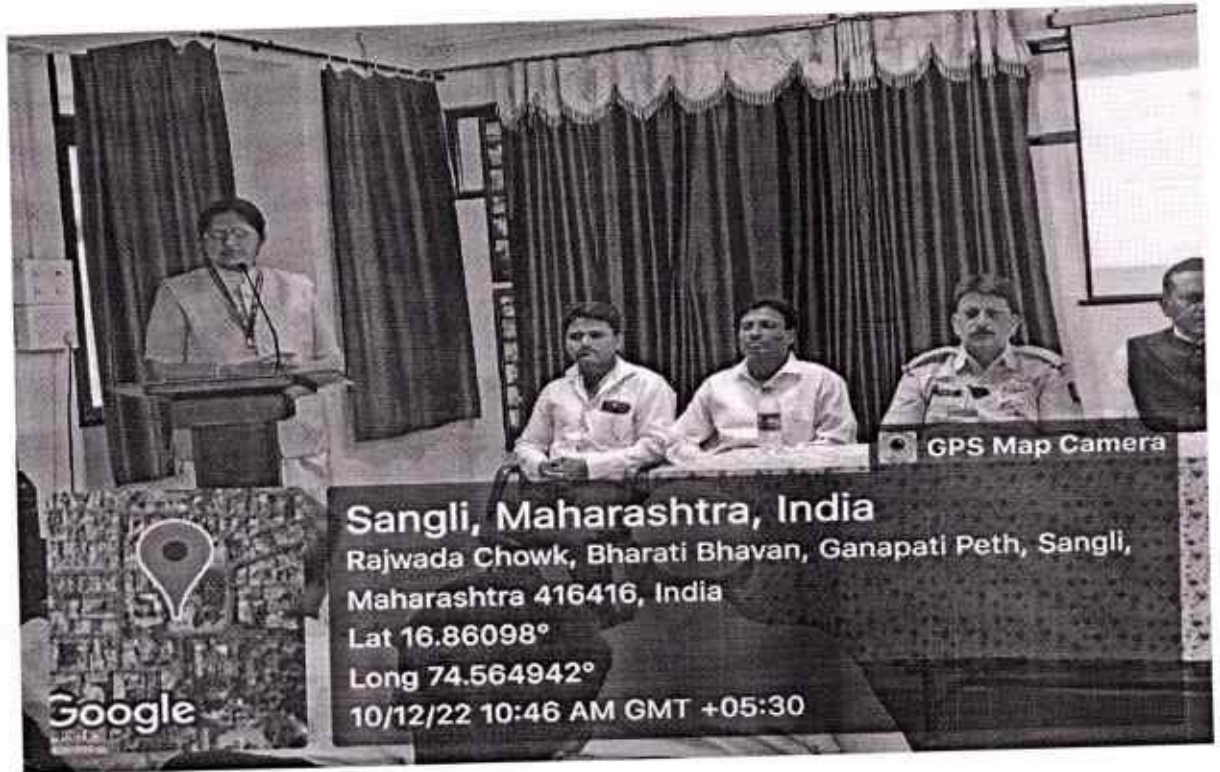
Hon. Hasabnis told that every human being is deserving of the right to live in a safe place. He said it's moral responsibility of every person to respect Human rights of another.
