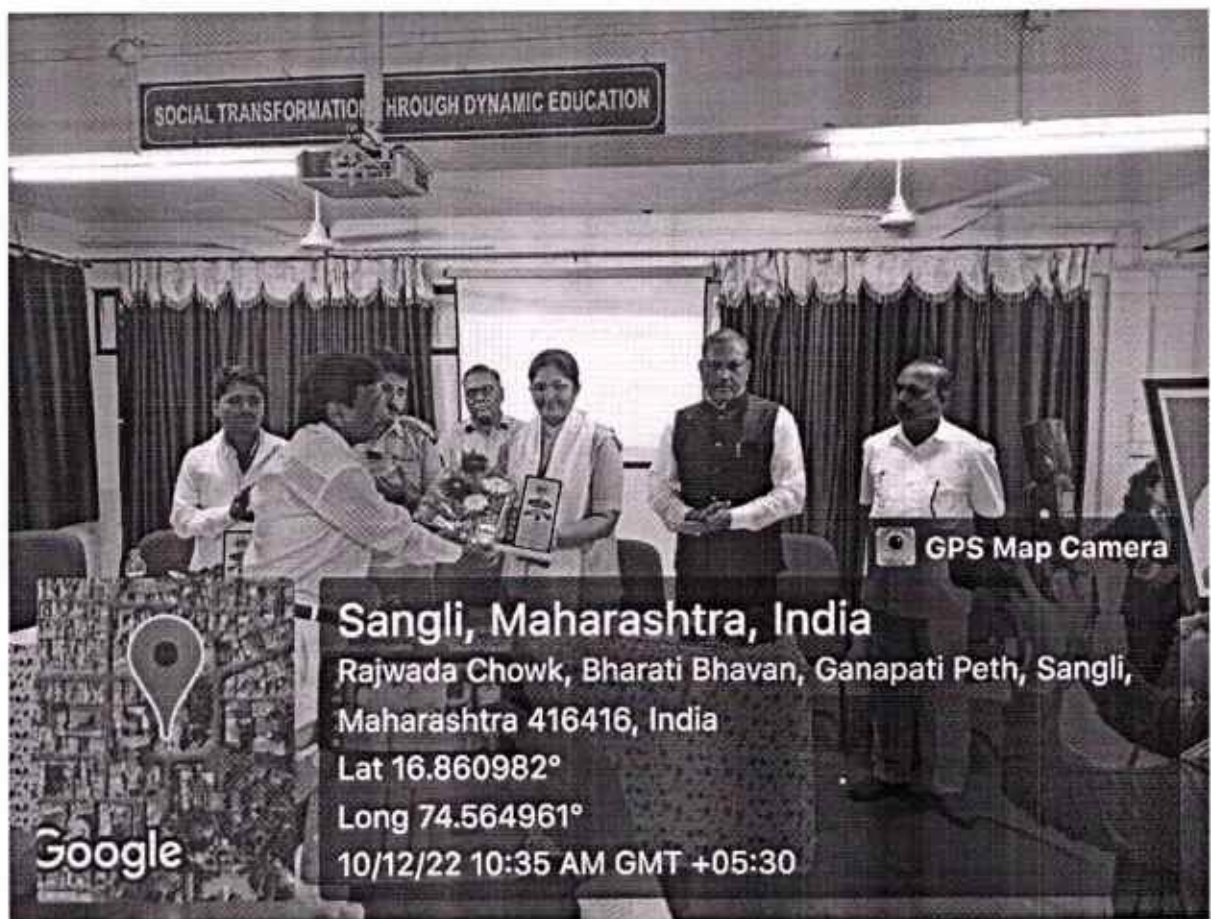

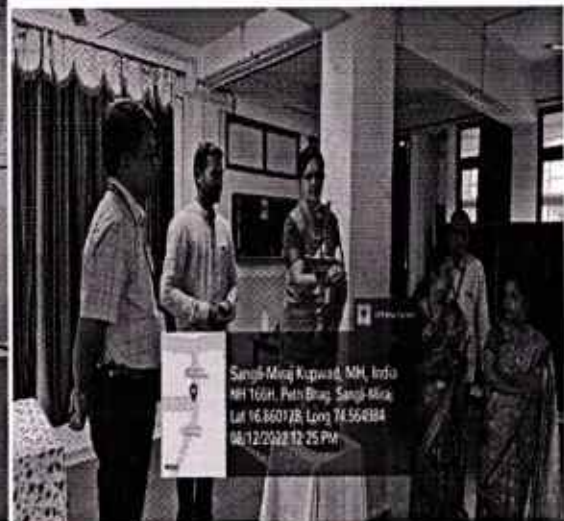
Theme allotted for the Group Song was: Patriotic, Folk, Nation building, Freedom Struggle, Composite culture or on any other Social issues.

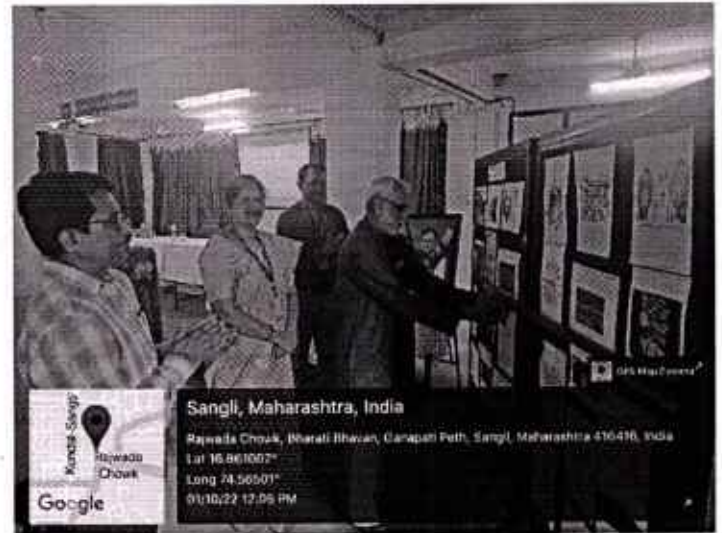
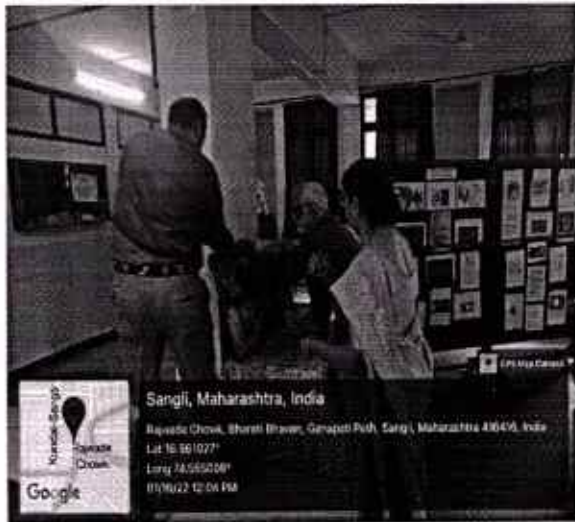
The program was organized with the objective to encourage feeling of national integration, peace, affection and communal harmony among the students.

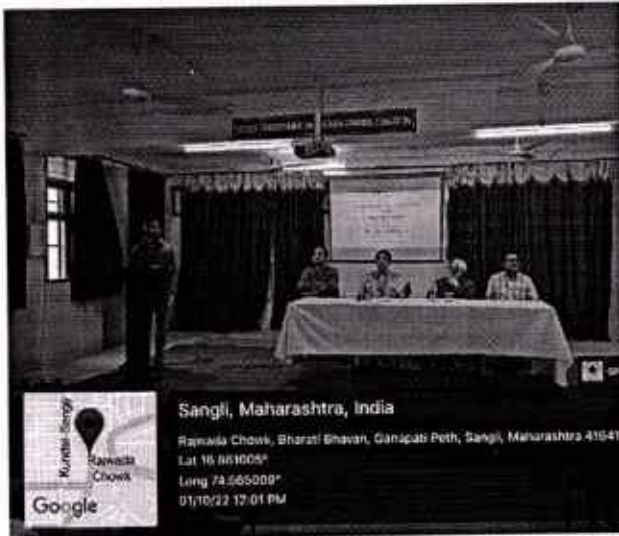

All the students are thankful to our Bharati Vidyapeeth's New Law College, Sangli for organizing such a grand Fresher's Party.

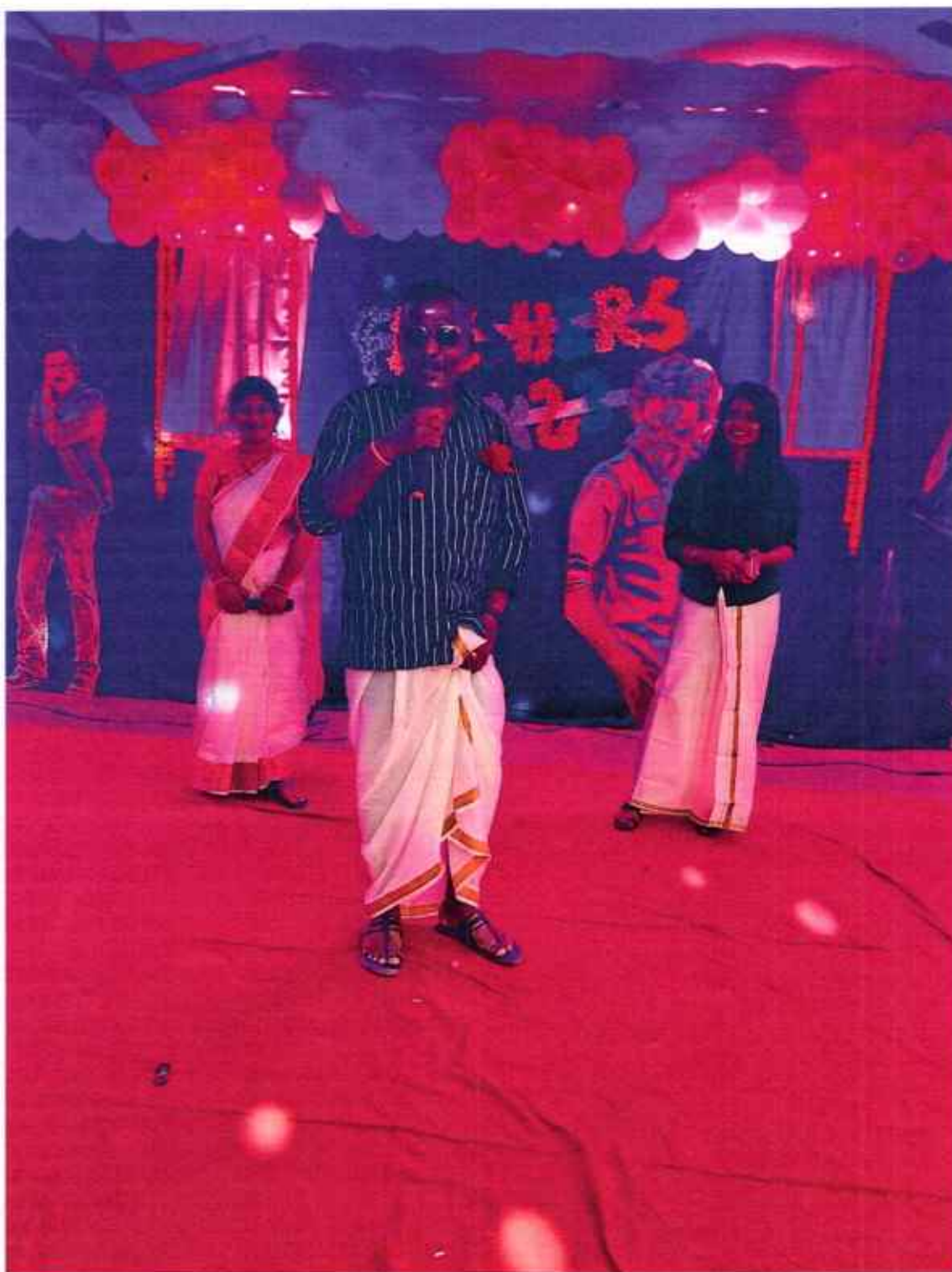

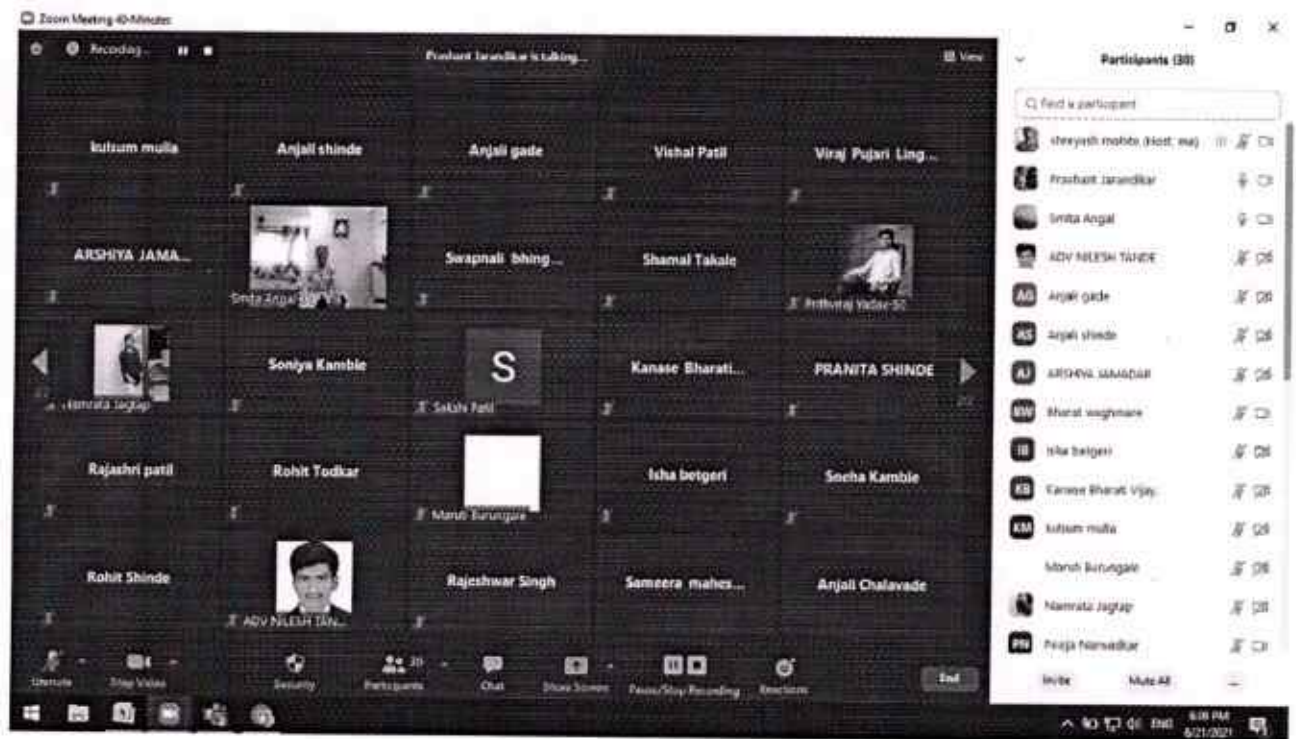

Teachers Day Celebration

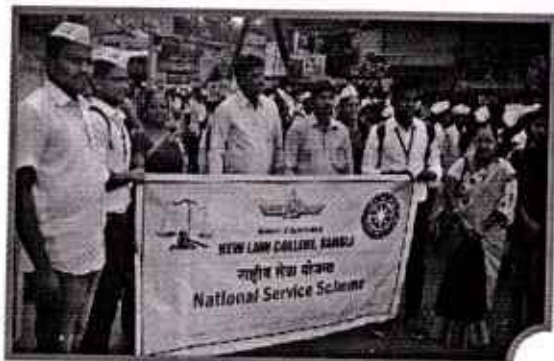

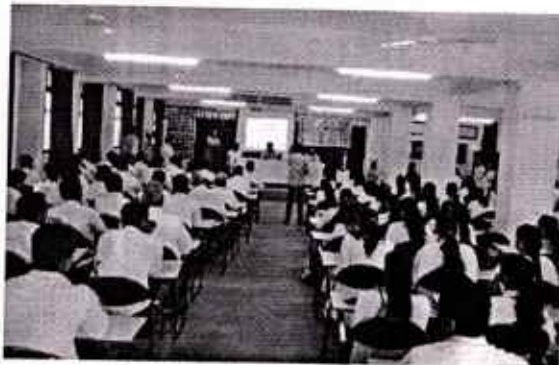
