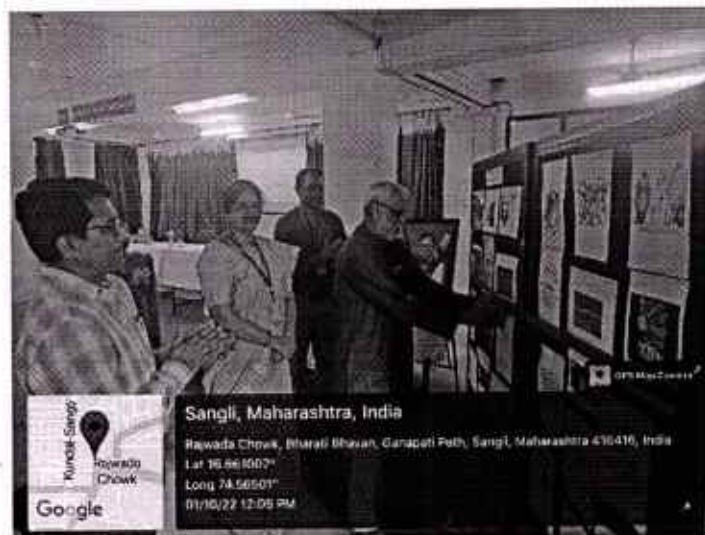
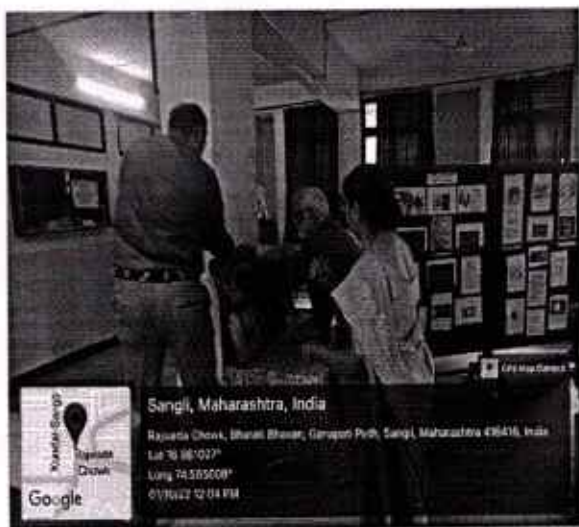
The program was organized with the objective to encourage feeling of national integration, peace, affection and communal harmony among the students.

- 6. How to file an application to get legal service?**


