# ANNUAL REPORT 2018-2019

The college was established in the year 1997 with the object of providing legal professionals and social engineers to fulfill the dream of *'Social Transformation though Dynamic Education'* of Hon'ble Dr. Patangrao Kadam, Founder of Bharati Vidyapeeth, Pune and the Chancellor of Bharati Vidyapeeth University, Pune. The main objective behind establishment of this college is to provide opportunity to rural masses that were outside the stream of education by providing quality legal education for Social transformation.

Initially in 1997, the college commenced the Under-Graduate Three Years Law course (LL.B.). The Five Years Law Course was started with the recognition of Government of Maharashtra and approved by the apex body Bar Council of India in 2001-02.

From the very inception, the college is serving the society with the Vision:

# "Quality Legal Education for Professional Competencies and Social Transformation"

The college has been accredited with NAAC, 'A' grade.

In academic year 18-19, the college commenced on 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2018. From 2016, the admissions to law course are carried through MH-Law CET and every year we conduct crash course for CET. This year, nearly, 100 students registered for this CET crash course.

In academic year 18-19, the new admissions are 40. The total strength of the college is 240.

In addition to this, the college conducts skill enhancing short term courses like, Cyber law, Proficiency in the use of English, Yoga and Advocacy skill with active support and guidance from the Department of Adult, Continuing Education and Extension Work, Shivaji University, Kolhapur. This year, the total admissions to these courses are nearly 90. And from next academic year we are commencing a course in Forensic Law and Criminology.

#### • CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

To prepare the students to face the challenges in the competitive world, the college organizes different co-curricular activities. The students are encouraged to participate in Moot Court and Mock Trial and other competitions held at National, State and Local level.

This year our students secured second **position in State Level Moot court competition** at Satara.

And, Ms.Sufiya Mujawar got second prize in District Level Elocution Competition

#### • EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

In Extra–curricular activities, we arrange, 'Vidhi Pushpa' law lecture series, wherein Hon'ble. Judges, renowned advocates, academicians, social and political activists are invited to deliver lectures. This year also we arranged 5 to 6 lectures under Vidhi pushp law lecture series.

# • RESEARCH CONSULTANCY AND EXTENSION

The College always encourages the faculty members to enhance teaching learning skills along with the theoretical inputs through participation in national and international workshops, seminars, conferences.

This year the college organized two Faculty development programs.
