FOR ADMINISTRATION:

FOR TEACHERS:

- A teacher should respect the privacy of others and confidential information confessed by colleagues and students.
- 7. A teacher does not engage in activities which adversely affect the qualities of professional ethics.
- 8. A teacher should integrate his teaching and learning with his or her research.
- 9. All teachers should obey the rules and regulations prescribed by BCI, Shivaji University, UGC, Govt of Maharashtra and Bharati Vidyapeeth.

FOR STUDENTS:

- 1. Students shall abide by the rules and regulations of the College and behave in a way that highlights the discipline of the College.
- 2. A six-day working schedule from Monday to Saturday is followed. The classes are scheduled stream-wise. The students shall attend the national anthem and the classes punctually.
