- Controlling carbon emission (carbon credits), curbing air, noise pollution through 'No Vehicle Day', and by prohibition of crackers.
- Economizing/Curtailing use of consumable items/stationary, reuse of papers, use of recycled paper (tie-up with recycle paper manufacturers)
- Adopting to paperless practices
- Prohibition of plastic bags, promoting use of paper/cotton bags, folders, handmade papers
